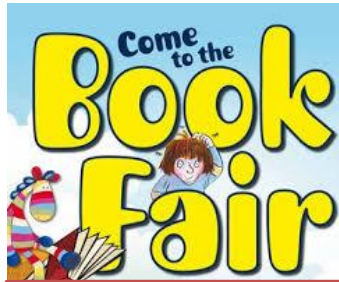


## PARENT/TEACHER MEETINGS
